University's Role in Assessment:

- Cumulative Grade Points (CGP), ranging from A++ to fail, are used by the university to add granularity to the evaluation process.

Result Declaration and Classification:

- Results are systematically declared, categorizing students into different classes based on their performance - distinction, first class, higher second class, second class, pass category, and fail.
- This comprehensive classification provides a nuanced understanding of the student's achievements.

Allow to Keep Terms (ATKT):

- The 'Allow to Keep Terms' (ATKT) concept is implemented, recognizing that students may face challenges in clearing all subjects in a single attempt.

- ATKT allows students to progress academically while addressing any subject-specific shortcomings.

Dissemination of Results:

- After the declaration of the result, the college systematically disseminates information at various levels - subject, class, and program.
- Results are prominently displayed on notice boards for easy access and reference by students.

Curriculum Review and Updates:


- The backbone of the assessment process lies in the curriculum designed by the university through its Board of Studies.
